## Lodge profile

Cabbell Lodge No.807 is a Masonic Lodge in the county of Norfolk. The Lodge is held at the Norwich Masonic Rooms, 47 St Giles Street, Norwich NR2 1JR. The Lodge meets at 6pm 7 times a year on the last Thursday of January (Installation) to April and September to November. We also meet every Wednesday at 7.30pm during those months for our School of Instruction and to socialise.

The Lodge was Consecrated at the Star Inn, Norwich on Thursday, 19th April 1860, which makes it the third oldest Lodge that currently meets in Norwich. It was named after the Provincial Grand Master of the time, Benjamin Bond Cabbell of Cromer Hall. Originally the Lodge was Founded for the shopkeepers of Norwich to be able to meet on the traditional half day closing on Thursday's, but we now have Members from many professions, ages and all walks of life who strive to uphold and maintain the Masonic values of Integrity, Friendship, Respect and Charity.

We have many younger Members who enjoy the social side of Freemasonry and the Lodge hosts a variety of events including an annual Ladies night in January. We are also keen to support Local Charities as well as larger National ones.
